



Successful Attendance at OTC .09

Energy professionals from more than 120 countries met at the 2009 Offshore Technology Conference (OTC) held May 4-7 in Houston, Texas. Attendance at the world's largest offshore resources industry event reached almost 67,000 despite a global economic recession and initial concerns about swine flu.

The 2009 exhibition was the second largest in OTC's 40-year history, with more than 557,000 square feet of exhibition area filled to capacity by 2,500 companies from 38 countries.
